Until May 20, 2021, fill out the application form, draw up an article in accordance with the requirements and send it to the address below. Before submitting article materials, it is recommended to check the text for uniqueness in the available anti-plagiarism programs. The allowed level is 55%.

The minimum article volume is 5 pages (including a list of references). The maximum volume of an article is 8 pages (including a list of references).

The preferred number of authors of the article is not more than 3 authors.
Participation in the round table is free.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMALIZATION OF ARTICLES

1. Editor: Microsoft Word or OpenOfficeWriter.
2. Language - Kazakh, Russian, English.
3. Page size - A 4, sheet orientation - "portrait".
4. Page margins: Top - 2 cm; Lower - 2 cm.; Left - 1.5 cm; Right - 3 cm.
5. Font "Times New Roman", size - 14.
6. Line spacing - single (1.0).
7. Indentation of the paragraph: Left - 0; On the right - 0; The first line (red line) is 1.25 cm.
8. In the upper left corner, MRNTI / UDC is indicated.
9. The first paragraph of the article: centered, bold, capital letters - Full title of the article.
10. The second paragraph of the article: centered, bold, italic - full name. author (authors), academic degree, academic title or position (authors), in full (12 font).
11. The third paragraph of the article: centered, italic - city, place of work, country (abbreviations not allowed) (12 font) (see sample below).
12. The fourth paragraph of the article: in the center, italics - summary (at least 50 - no more than 100 words) and keywords (3-5 words) (in Kazakh / Russian, English) (12 font)
13. The text of the article (14 font): formatting - by width. Breaks of sections, pages, columns, the use of sparse or condensed letter spacing are not allowed in articles.
14. Text in hard-to-read fonts, graphics, diagrams, pictures, etc. scanned and inserted into the article in the form of a picture with a resolution of at least 300 dpi.
15. Automatic numbering of the bibliography is not allowed. The numbering of lists in the text is done manually.
16. References (12 fonts) are drawn up at the end of the article in the order of using the literature, in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5-2008. References in the text to the relevant sources are made in square brackets: the ordinal number of the source from the list of references and the page, for example [5, p. 17]. The use of automatic paging links is not permitted.
17. Pagination is not allowed.
18. The authors are asked to carefully proofread and edit the materials. The authors are responsible for the content of the articles, for the accuracy of the facts, citations, statistical and other data, names, titles and other information given in the article.

The organizing committee reserves the right to select articles. Materials submitted later than the specified deadline or not drawn up in accordance with the requirements are not considered and will not be returned back.

Materials that are prepared strictly in accordance with the requirements and the application must be sent to the e-mail addresses pedagogikaumanov@mail.ru marked "MCC - Yubileiny G.A.Umanov".
